



CURRICULUM INTENT

The Philosophy, Religion and Ethics (PRE) is a core subject and a distinctive offering at Avanti Fields. Its curriculum intent is to examine the most basic questions concerning human existence (the relationship between the living entity and the Supreme Entity), (the means for attaining the object of pursuit) and (the very object of pursuit) namely Man, the world, and God. The PRE curriculum main focus is developing an appreciation and deepening one's faith in the Chaitanya Hindu tradition, and it rests upon the beliefs, teachings and practices lived and taught by Sri Chaitanya. This includes the key philosophical concepts of the Bhagavad-gita: the self, work and purpose, the nature of this world, the impact of time and connection with the Divine.
