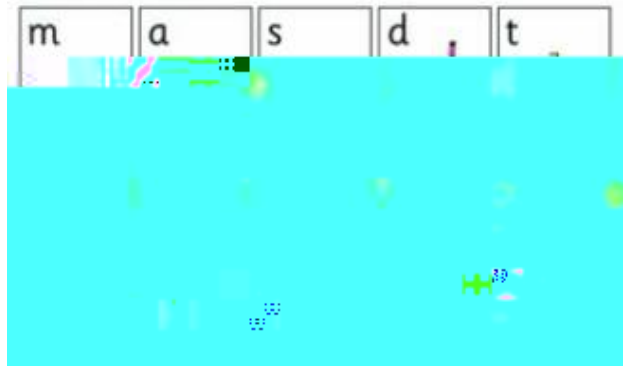


We want to foster a love for writing at a young age. Providing your child with hands-on experiences are great way to spark their creativity with writing. This might include talking and writing about what your child might see in the woods.

Most children will be learning Set 1 sounds. Please work with them at home to help them say these sounds speedily.



At school, we use Fred talk to help us to blend. Fred says the sounds before reading the words. Encourage your child to now use 'Fred in their head' to read the following words: Can you Fred talk some of these words?

mad, sat, tip, pit, tin, sit

Red words are words you cannot sound out. Help your child to recognise these words. Remember do not sound out the words, just say it!
