- " On occasions, some teachers do not use activities that are precisely matched to help pupils learn the intended curriculum. Some pupils do not learn as well as they should as a result. Leaders should ensure all teachers consistently use the most appropriate activities so pupils learn as well as they can.
- " In a small number of subjects in key stage 3, the curriculum is not as well

### Information about this inspection

The inspectors carried out this graded inspection under section 5 of the Education Act 2005.

- " This was the first routine inspection the school received since the COVID-19 pandemic began. Inspectors discussed the impact of the pandemic with leaders and have taken that into account in their evaluation of the school.
- " Inspectors carried out deep dives in early reading, English, mathematics, history and geography. For each deep dive, the inspector discussed the curriculum with leaders, visited lessons, spoke with teachers and pupils and looked at samples of pupils' work.
- " The lead inspector listened to a sample of children in the Reception Year reading to a familiar adult.
